**3. Matters Arising from Minutes of the Previous Meeting**

Llanfairfechan's grant for £5,000 from the CA to help with the new club house has gone through subject to the project going ahead.

#### **4. Reports from Officers**

##### **A Chairman - Barry Keen**

Congratulations to Crake Valley on winning the CA Apps Heley Award.

##### **B. Secretary - Ian Lines**

The Croquet in the North leaflets have been produced and distributed to:

- Yorkshire Regional Federation
- Croquet North Regional Federation
- All those NW clubs attending the NW Fed Spring Meeting.

##### **C. Treasurer - Geoff Young**

Affiliation Fees have been received from the 14 clubs in the NW Federation.

The £500 grant from the CA for last year has been received.

##### **D. Development Officer - Keith Roberts**

Barry Keen drew attention to a CA course on Lawn Maintenance at Bingley on Wednesday 31<sup>st</sup> October 2007 being run by the Sports Turf Research Institute (STRI). The aim is for each Federation to send at least one representative. Peter Taylor is going on behalf of the NW Federation as he is the NW representative on the CA Lawn Advisory Group. 16 further places are available at a cost of £10. Clubs should nominate other individuals (who must be CA members) whom they wish to attend to Keith Roberts as soon as possible, who will then liaise with Barry Keen (the course organiser) at the end of June as to who should attend. If the October course is oversubscribed then the CA will consider organising a further course in 2008. It was noted that STRI can visit clubs for £250, of which the CA will contribute £100.

Keith Roberts reported the following development activity at clubs:

##### **Bowdon**

Still has a CA grant for £2500 for new storage which has not yet been taken up (See Minute 7 below)

##### **Bury**

Was unsuccessful in its bid for the Townsend Trophy for the most improved two lawn club 2005-2006

##### **Chester**

Reviewed their plans for a new clubhouse and are proposing a cheaper alternative which involve applying for a grant of £700 from the CA and £100 from the Federation

##### **Crake Valley**

Jointly won the Apps-Heley award for the most improved 3/4 lawn club in 2005-2006. They are considering the development of a fourth lawn which the FDO feels sure will be supported by the CA.

##### **Fylde**

Will continue to develop their excellent new site. The FDO is sure that any relevant applications will have the support of both the CA and the NWF.

##### **Llanfairfechan**

A grant of £5000 has been awarded by the CA to new club house project subject to the project receiving full funding.

##### **Southport**

Members have approved a significant increase in fees in order to provide the basis for investment in substantial lawn renovations and renewals.

##### **E. League Manager - John Wilkinson**

All league fixtures are in place.

Golf captains are reminded to take careful note of league rules and arrangements.

##### **F. Coaching Officer - John Haslam / James Hawkins**

John Haslam is organising a list of qualified coaches.

James Hawkins reported that course for coaches at Bowdon on 10-11<sup>th</sup> March 2007 was not happening, partly due to him being somewhat poorly.

James Hawkins has had a rethink on how these courses should be run in future. In view of the difficulty of organising such courses, he believes that it will be better to break the course up, and deal with smaller groups, with James travelling to clubs where several individuals require coaching. Anybody wishing such coaching should contact James direct.

The laws/referees course at Bowdon on 17-18 March 2007 is full.

### **G. C.A. Representative - Barry Keen**

The CA is giving £10 to clubs for every new CA individual member that they get to join.

The CA has been reviewing its organisation, and in view of the fact that 1/3 to 1/4 of club members play only golf, all CA committees will now be joint, with the exception of the Association and Golf Tournament Committees. The CA is also looking at ways in which it can do more to support 'social' players.

The structure of the CA website is being reviewed in terms of whether it should be more focussed on marketing and recruiting new members, or whether it should be aimed mainly at existing CA members as at present.

Congratulations to Crake on winning the Apps Heley award, and a cheque for £100.

The CA have had more than 700 returns to their recent survey, and results will be published next month. John Saxby expressed a concern that the CA had asked for details of club members who were not individual members of the CA, and Barry Keen promised to investigate.

The CA have decided that if the entry doesn't improve for the Women's Championship in 2008, then it will be dropped.

A famous old CA trophy, the Beddows Cup, has been found and will be awarded to the winners of the Inter-Club.

The standard CA Lawn hire fee will increase from £20 to £22 in 2008.

GB won the MacRobertson Shield convincingly in Australia. In 2010 it will be held in GB, with the final at Cheltenham and 4 other venues likely to be used (Bowdon, Heaton Park and Southport are possibilities).

The high speed filming day at Bowdon was very successful and interesting, and the results have been analysed and are being considered by the CA Council. We await guidance from the CA on whether straight, close (<5mm) 'scatter shots' should be considered faults, even if they are not technically double taps. The filming also showed that apparently clean hammer shots can technically be double taps, and that close angled hoops hit hard are often not faults (though this will depend on conditions). It is likely that a DVD will be available shortly. No immediate changes to the laws are proposed, but a new version (6.1), to incorporate the current commentary and other minor changes, will be produced for the start of the 2008 season. The golf laws are also being reissued for the start of the next Antipodean season.

Liz Wilson and the meeting thanked Barry Keen for keeping the Federation informed of all the CA developments.

### **H. Championship Manager - Keith Roberts**

Liz Wilson will send out entry forms to clubs as per usual.

Clubs are encouraged to organise early and enter this very enjoyable event.

### **I. Pennine Cup Captain - Paul Rigge**

The North West are hosts this year, and the event will be held at Pendle & Craven. There is some confusion over the date – the NW and Pendle web sites indicate 22 or 23 September – Kathryn Schofield will investigate and inform Ian Lines as soon as possible.

### **J. Child Protection Officer - Barry Keen**

Child Protection status now has to be arranged locally, and can't be done through the CA. Barry Keen and the CA are still available to provide advice.

## **5. Millennium Competitions**

The Advanced at Heaton Park on 31 March -1 April 2007 is full (9 in A and 8 in B).

For the Handicap at Chester on 19-20 May 2007, Janet Davies has sent out forms to club secretaries, which are due to be returned by 30 March. Clubs should nominate 4 people, of whom 2 are guaranteed entry.

### **Bowdon - John Saxby**

Planning permission has been received for a new revised equipment hut. The CA requires Bowdon to reapply for the grant.

There are still spaces left in the June Advanced Weekend, Northern Week and Northern Championships.

### **Bury**

Following on from the installation of electricity more work has been carried out with the refurbishment of the club house. The floor level in the centre room has been raised to match that of the adjoining rooms, thus reducing the risk of trips and falls. Work is ongoing to eliminate the problem of damp in the clubhouse and general maintenance inside and out has also been carried out.

This work has not stopped members meeting socially during the winter to enjoy a variety of activities – but we haven't got around to playing Canasta yet!

Members are looking forward to the start of the new, and busy, season.

Bury is holding 2 Fun Days (for which leaflets have been distributed to clubs):

- Sunday 29<sup>th</sup> July – Association Alternate Shot, 10 minute Croquet and Flamingoes
- Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> August – Golf Croquet Fun Games

There are still spaces available in the Lancashire International Golf Croquet Championship at Heaton Park on 14-15 April 2007.

The Solomon Trophy (GB v USA test match) will be held at Heaton Park on 18-21 July. People are encouraged to spectate at this very important international event with some of the worlds top players.

We were initially turned down by Welsh Assembly Communities and Facilities, but after discussion with them are re-applying. In order to demonstrate the level of popular support we are circulating a petition around the area, and delegates are encouraged to sign at the meeting today. So far we have £10,500 promised or given plus £7,000 from our own resources.

### **Penrith and North Lakes U3A - Elsie Hare**

We moved to a new venue last year and now play at Edenhall and Langwathby Sports Club ground where the conditions are a great improvement but still not ideal. We hope to tackle the weeds and slight undulations this year.

We had an excellent day of coaching from Barry Keen and members really appreciated his coming so far to help us.

There were 10 fully paid-up members by the end of the season, and we lost one member who has moved to New Zealand. Towards the end of the season we recruited 3 more who will be members this year.

We held an Open Day in July which did provoke interest and resulted in 2 new members, but we hope to attract more this year.

We are very keen to keep playing and improving.

### **Southport and Birkdale - John Haslam**

Southport are planning a lot of lawn improvement work over the next 3-5 years, totalling about £18,000, and will be looking to the CA for grants. One key difference is that they will be working with outside contractors. There is a possibility that they may wish to bid to be a venue for the MacRobertson Shield in 2010.

## **8. Changes to the Constitution**

David Barrett outlined some suggested changes relating to Election of Officers:

- A All Officers are elected for a period of one year.
- B Any Officer may be elected to another office in the following year. An Officer may be re-elected to the same office subject to a limit of three years' tenure. This limit may be waived in emergency with the consent of a two-thirds majority.

David Barrett explained that it was his belief that such an amendment would encourage a more healthy and vibrant willingness of members to take on an Officers duties, knowing they are for a maximum term (rather than the possibility of a LIFETIME responsibility.)

David also thought that members from 'smaller' Clubs often feel that as they are not representing one of the 'Big Membership Clubs' they hold back their willingness to take Office. This might encourage them and everyone else to keep a lively interest in the whole Federation.

There was some discussion and a range of views were expressed.

Barry Keen noted that the Constitution needed updating in terms of other matters, such as trustees and gender issues. Barry Keen volunteered to review the constitution and work with David Barrett, Geoff Young and Ian Lines to develop a revised version, for consideration by clubs by June, so that firm proposals can be made before the NW Fed AGM in November.
